## <Overview>

Asian universities have developed rapidly within the context of globalization. For this seminar, we have invited the president of Hong Kong Baptist University, which has constructed a university governance system and is proactively advancing university reforms. The president will speak on higher education policy in Hong Kong, as well as on the status and challenges of the reforms being advanced at the university level, in terms of the role of the university president. Additionally, the presidents of Japanese universities will present their thoughts on the role of the president and what they should accomplish in consideration of the status of university reforms. Through these presentations and the exchange of opinions with participants, we will seek out a university structure for strategically implementing university reforms.

JUAA is conducting this seminar for the purpose of contributing to the development of higher education in Japan. The seminar aims to deepen the level of discourse between the presidents and vice-presidents of full-member universities and junior colleges, and to examine the roles and missions that higher education must fulfill in the future.
