Japan University Accreditation Association (JUAA) was established in 1947. Since then, we have consistently led the development and implementation of higher education quality assurance in Japan. We encourage and support universities' improvement through accreditation and its research.

In recent years, higher education has come to play a crucial role in supporting socio-economic growth and global competitiveness. At the same time, the demand for quality assurance of higher education institutions is increasing throughout the world. JUAA plays an important role as a quality assurance agency in Japan. We will continue to strengthen cooperation and collaboration with higher education institutions and relevant organizations both in Japan and abroad to support higher education.

ABOUT US

JUAA is a voluntary (non-profit) organization that was established on July 8, 1947, taking several U.S. accreditation organizations as a model. For its establishment, 46 universities gathered and approved the University Standards. We have been implementing accreditation since 1951 using these University Standards.

We are the first Certified Evaluation and Accreditation Agency for universities certified by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT) in 2004. We currently perform Certified Evaluation and Accreditation in nine fields.

We have a membership system (full or associate) with more than 460 members (national and local public and private universities) that account for 60% of all the universities in Japan. For our members, we hold seminars and workshops, among other events.

Certified Evaluation and Accreditation, a national mandatory evaluation and accreditation scheme for higher education in Japan, was introduced in 2004 to assure and enhance the quality of academic activities.

In this scheme, all higher education institutions must undergo external evaluation once every seven years, and all professional graduate schools must undergo it once every five years.

OUR MISSION

Our mission is "to promote the qualitative improvement of higher education institutions in Japan through the voluntary efforts and mutual assistance of member institutions and to contribute to international cooperation such as educational and research activities in higher education institutions."

To fulfill this mission, we are engaged in the following three activities.

Accreditation

We will assure the public of the quality of university education through evaluation, and continuously support the improvement and enhancement of universities.

Research

We will improve the evaluation system and contribute to the qualitative improvement of universities through research on domestic and international higher education.

International Cooperation

We will collaborate with overseas quality assurance agencies and support international development of universities.
