Introduction

In 2002, the Certified Evaluation and Accreditation (CEA) framework was introduced in Japan and came into effect in 2004, requiring all higher education institutions (universities, junior colleges and technical colleges) to undergo an evaluation once every seven years, and all professional graduate schools to undergo an evaluation once every five years. In each case, an accreditation agency certified by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology conducts the evaluation, comprehensively assessing the quality of education and other relevant areas.

Since its establishment in 1947, the Japan University Accreditation Association (JUAA) has played a significant role in assuring the quality of higher education in Japan through the establishment of university standards and mutual evaluation based on peer review among member universities in accordance with those standards. On August 31, 2004, JUAA was authorized by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology as the first Certified Evaluation and Accreditation Agency for universities. Its scope of accreditation was later expanded to multiple fields. JUAA currently conducts CEA in 11 fields (university, junior college, law school, professional graduate business school, professional graduate public policy school, professional graduate school of public health, professional graduate school of intellectual property studies, professional graduate school of global communications, professional graduate school of digital contents, professional graduate school of global legal studies, and professional graduate school of public relations) and program accreditation in two fields (veterinary medicine and dental education).

JUAA hereby announces the FY2025 accreditation results as follows.

FY2025 University Accreditation (Certified Evaluation and Accreditation for Universities) Results

Following the receipt of applications from 22 universities, JUAA conducted the evaluation

through the University Accreditation Committee and its subcommittees, including document analysis and site visits.
