Suggestions for Improvement

Mission and purpose

- The purposes of education and research, including the purposes of fostering persons of talent for the School of Nursing and the Faculty of Pedagogy (commuting course) have not been clearly defined in their regulations. This situation should be improved.

Faculty and faculty organization

- The procedures for hiring a full-time professor are not clearly stated. This should be improved.

Educational content, methods, and outcome

- Regarding the policies for designing and implementing curriculums in the University of KinDAI Himeji as a whole, the School of Nursing, and the Faculty of Pedagogy, basic ideas on educational content and methods should be stipulated and made public.
- The maximum number of credits students can register for per year has not been set in the Faculty of Pedagogy (commuting course). This should be improved in accordance with the purpose of having a credit system.

Enrollment

- The ratio of transfer students to the transfer student admission cap is low at 0.20 in the Faculty of Pedagogy (commuting course). This should be improved.

Education and research environment

- Full-time librarians with professional knowledge have not been hired for the library. This should be improved.

Internal quality assurance

- Among the information that is required to be open to the public by law, the degrees and achievements held by each professor and the syllabi of the classes are not released, except for a few professors and classes. This situation should be improved.
