Suggestions for Improvement

Enrollment

- The ratio of enrolled students to the student enrollment cap is low at 0.89 in the Faculty of Allied Health Sciences and at 0.19 in the Graduate School of Rehabilitation. These situations should be improved.

Administration and finance

- In the regulation of the University Management Committee as the institution's top decision-making body, procedures for making decisions are not defined. This should be improved.
- Although the financial situation of Niigata University of Rehabilitation (hereafter, the University) is very difficult, the attainment targets concerning such items as the establishment of a financial base and the formulation of a financial plan have not been set. The University should formulate its mid- and longterm financial plans and set the concrete objectives, and these plans should be examined every year and be continuously reviewed.
