In 2017, JUAA has 337 universities as full members.

JUAA's mission is to promote the qualitative improvement of higher education institutions in Japan. JUAA started accrediting activities in 1951 for universities applying for full membership in the JUAA.

On August 31, 2004, JUAA was certified by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT) as the first Certified Evaluation and Accreditation Agency for universities in Japan.

JUAA currently performs Certified Evaluation and Accreditation in 8 fields (Universities, Junior colleges, Law Schools, Business Schools, Public Policy Schools, Schools of Public Health, Intellectual Property Studies, and Schools of Global Communication) and Program Evaluation for Schools of veterinary medicine.
